2nd SELECTION COMPETITION

FOR ERASMUS+ TRAINEESHIP MOBILITIES FOR STUDENTS IN THE FIELD OF HEALTH SCIENCES ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-2025

The Erasmus+ Office of the International Relations Department organizes the selection competition for student Erasmus+ traineeship mobilities (SMP), academic year 2024-2025.

These mobilities can be accessed by:

- Students enrolled at the **Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Medicine in English: 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th year of study**
- Students enrolled at the **Faculty of Dental Studies – Dental Studies in English: 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th year of study**
- Students enrolled at the **Faculty of Pharmacy- 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th year of study**
- Students enrolled at **Nutrition and Dietetics: 1st and 2nd year of study**
- Students enrolled at **Nursing: 1st, 2nd and 3rd year of study**
- Students enrolled at **Medical cosmetics and technology of cosmetic product: 1st and 2nd year of study**
- Students enrolled at **Medicinal Chemistry: 1st and 2nd year of study**
- Students enrolled at **Dental Technology: 1st and 2nd year of study**
- Students enrolled at **Hydrotherapy, Kinesiology and Medical Rehabilitation: 1st and 2nd year of study**

Details

The Erasmus+ traineeship mobility can be carried out in a university, a teaching or private hospital, in a private practice, laboratory, research institute, pharmacy, etc.

The selected students will receive funding only if they obtain a *letter of acceptance* from the host institution, signed by the head of the department concerned. The eligible countries for carrying out the Erasmus placement mobility are: countries from the EU + Turkey, Switzerland, Faeroe Islands, Great Britain, Andorra, Monaco, San Marino, Macedonia, Serbia.

The duration of the mobility is of 2 months and can ONLY take place after the last examination session of the academic year 2024-2025 and before the start of the academic next year 2025-2026. Students who have failed exams in the current academic year can begin their mobility only once the re-session (for failed exams and re-examinations) is over.

Mobility periods beyond the beginning of the next academic year (2025-2026), are not accepted.





Eligibility criteria:

- Students enrolled at George Emil Palade University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science and Technology of Târgu Mureș

Selection criteria:

- **FULL CREDITED STUDENTS IN THE COMPLETED YEARS OF STUDY**
- **Academic performance:** arithmetic average of completed years of study (average X 10)
- **Scientific performance:** Number of abstracts published in journals as first author (n X 3) and as co-author (max. 3 abstracts 3X1). For each abstract, only one author (the first) will be considered first author.

Please note! That during the application process (see below), you have to enter only the average/score for each category. All the necessary calculations for the final score will be done automatically.

Only documented performance will be considered. For each abstract you have to provide: the cover of the journal or abstract volume, the page containing the name, period and location of the scientific event, the page(s) containing the abstract).

- **The status of tutor/demonstrator.** It should be supported by a certificate released by the Dean's Office, and also signed by the head of the department concerned.

Only the tutor/demonstrator activity carried out prior to the selection call (at least the previous semester) will be taken into consideration. The total score obtained after evaluation of the file will be increased by the commission by 10%, according to the internal rules of the university.

Green travel and fewer opportunities

Participants who qualify for the fewer opportunities grant (eg. students who benefit or qualify to benefit from fewer opportunities scholarship (bursa sociala) at the George Emil Palade UMFST), will receive a supplementary amount. Participants who use a **green travel** means of transport to the host institution (carpooling, bus, train) will receive an additional amount of 50 Euro/mobility. More information about green travel opportunities top-up, please consult the following link [Top-up green travel](#)

Selection file

The selection file must contain the following documents in PDF format, **each document no larger than 5 MB**:

- Cover letter
- Euro pass CV (PDF format)
- Identity card
- Evidence of the scientific performance. They will be loaded as **one single document** for each criterion, containing all the evidence for that criterion, in PDF format
- Certificate released by the Dean's Office, and also signed by the head of the department concerned.





Mobility Online Platform. The management of Erasmus mobility will be performed exclusively online using the **Mobility Online platform**, a platform dedicated to Erasmus+ activities. On the International Relations - Erasmus website, you will find the tutorial on how to use the platform. **Please read the instructions in the tutorial carefully and follow them exactly.**
